INCREASE OF FINES FOR USE OF ATVs ON STATE GAME LANDS

WHEREAS: it is illegal to operate an ATV or other off road motorized vehicle, such as dirt bikes, on State Game Lands, except on designated roads open for persons issued a Disabled Persons Permit,

WHEREAS: the use of ATVs on State Game Lands is causing irreparable damage to roads, food plots, and other lands and streams,

WHEREAS: the use of ATVs on State Game Lands disturb both animals and birds and all wildlife,

WHEREAS: the State Game Lands were paid for through the purchase of Pennsylvania Hunting Licenses and through various sportsmen's groups, and ATVs disrupt many hunters enjoying the outdoors and the pursuit of game,

WHEREAS: the fine at present for riding an ATV on State Game Lands is \$100.00,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Schuylkill Spurs Chapter of the National Wild Turkey Federation proposed through the Schuylkill Sportsmen's Association at its May 27, 2010 meeting,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Pennsylvania Federation of Sportsmen's Club Clubs recommend to the Pennsylvania Game Commission that the fine for operating an ATV or similar off road motorized vehicle, such as dirt bikes, on Pennsylvania State Game lands be increased to \$500 per occurrence.
